1. Who We Are

Brondesbury Sports Club (BSC) provides Tennis, Cricket and Squash membership and related sporting activities. Brondesbury Sports Club Ltd is a company registered in England and Wales under company registration number 10015162. The registered office address is Brondesbury Sports Club, 5a Harman Drive, London, NW2 2EB, UK.

2. Background to this Privacy Policy

On 25 May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force, replacing the Data Protection Act 1998. GDPR requires organisations to review how personal data is collected, used, stored and protected.

This Privacy Policy explains how Brondesbury Sports Club complies with GDPR and how we use personal data lawfully, fairly and transparently.

Under GDPR, one of the lawful bases for processing personal data is 'legitimate interests'. This means we may process personal data where we have a genuine and legitimate reason to do so, provided this does not override your rights and freedoms.

When you provide personal information to us, we use it only for legitimate club purposes such as managing memberships, subscriptions and communications, in ways you would reasonably expect.

3. What Data We Collect and Why

We collect personal data relating to club membership, which may include:

Full name – to identify members

Email address – to communicate with members

Date of birth – to determine age-related membership categories

Address – for emergency situations or location-based membership criteria

Telephone number – to contact members where email is unsuccessful

Gender – for appropriate communication and gender-specific teams or activities

4. How Long We Keep Your Data

Members pay a one-off joining fee when joining Brondesbury Sports Club. To ensure that former members who rejoin are not charged this fee again, we retain membership records indefinitely unless a request is made for deletion of personal data.

5. Your Rights Under GDPR

Right to be informed – You have the right to know how and why your data is collected and used.

Right to rectification – You may request correction of inaccurate or incomplete personal data.

Right of access – You may access your personal data at any time via your membership account.

Right to erasure – You may request deletion of your personal data by contacting the Club. Requests will be processed within one month.

6. How We Use Your Data

Brondesbury Sports Club does not sell personal data to third parties. Personal data is used solely for membership administration, subscription reminders and club communications such as newsletters.

7. Data Security

We take data security seriously and use appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss or misuse. Security measures include website security controls and restricted access to personal data.
